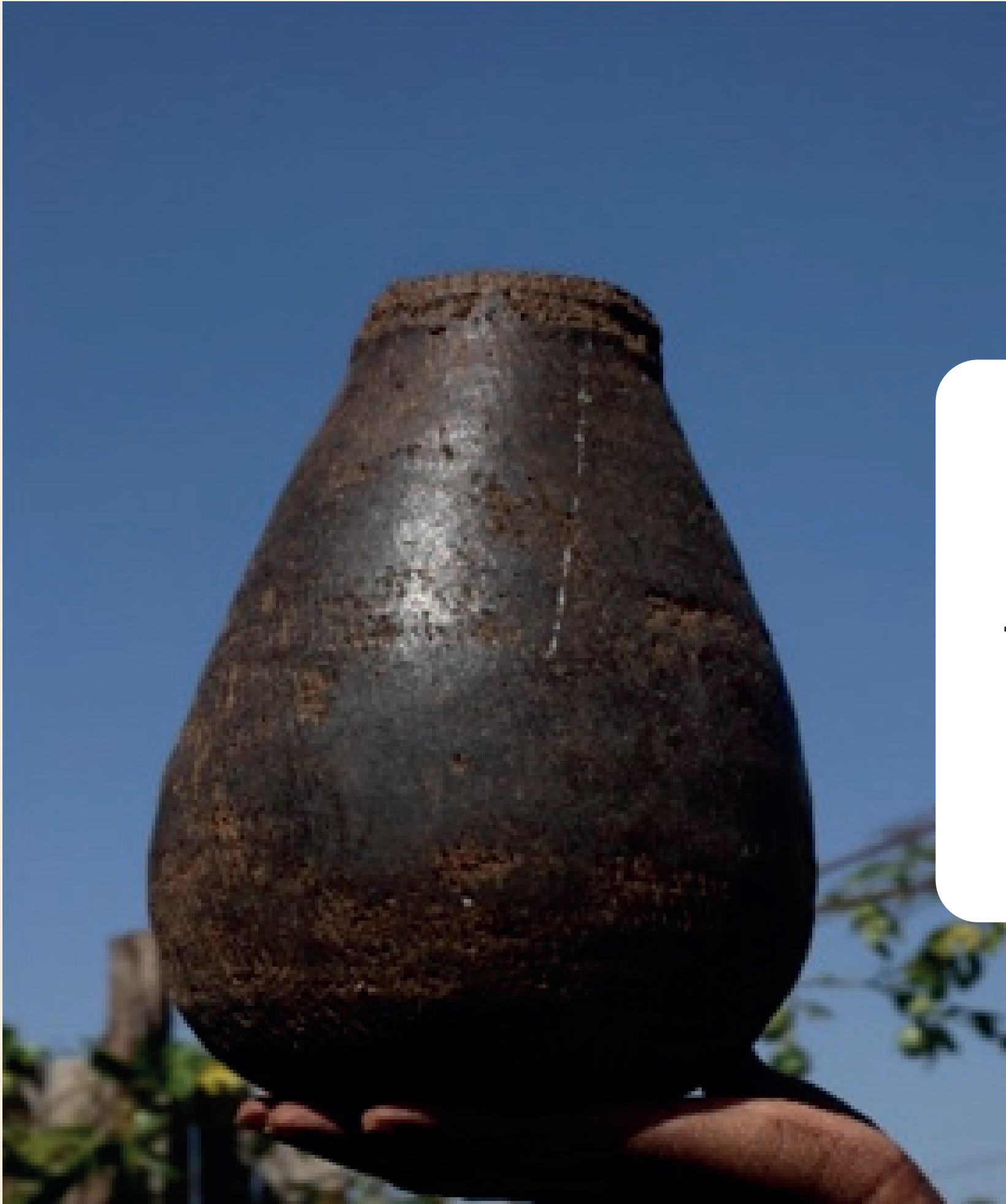




Name: Jijjo

Use: A container reserved for a husband's milk only.

Made: Crafted by women.

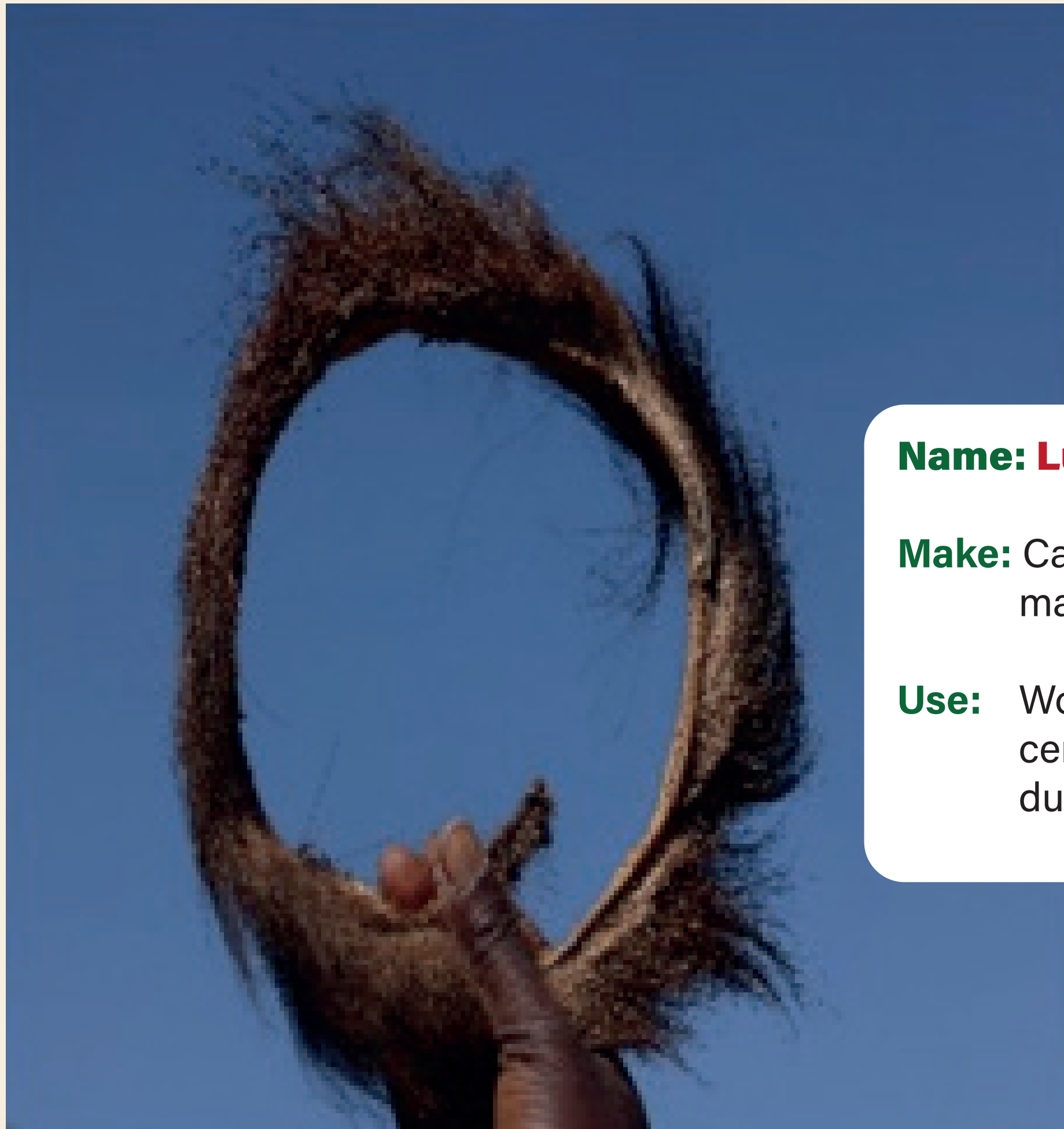


Name: Haan (Water Container)

Use: Used to store water and keep it cool

Make: Crafted from the bark of Ehelle roots, woven by women. Mothers also train their daughters in the weaving tradition

By: Made by women and older girls.



Name: Luff

Make: Carved from the hump of a young male camel.

Use: Worn only by married men as ceremonial headgear, especially during events such as Sorio.

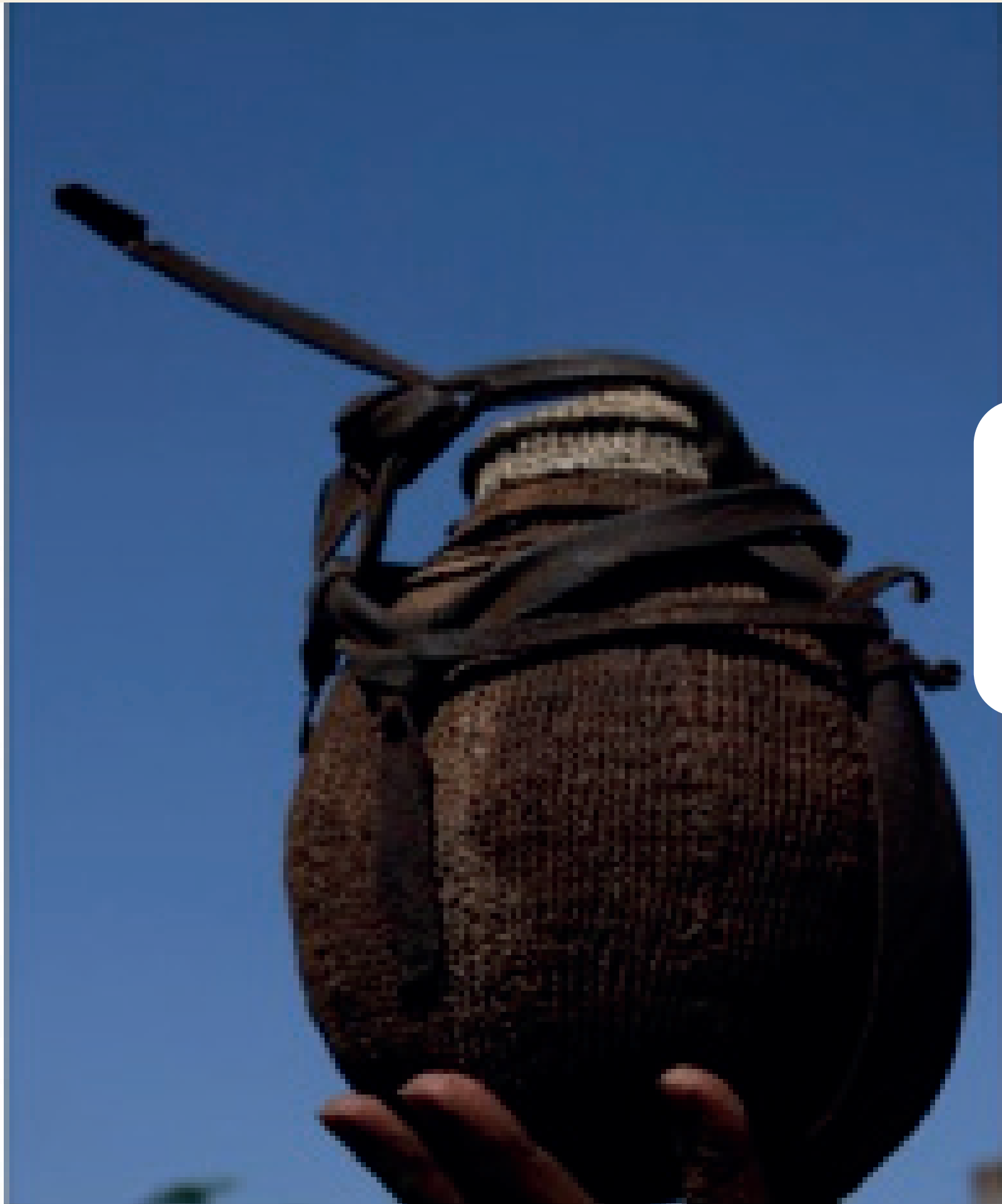


Name: Khure (Milk Container for Boys and Libation)

Use: Unlike the Rendile O'doola and Gal'Deylan containers, this one is specifically for boys and for pouring libations.

Make: Constructed from ergeeg and ddoom palm leaves.





Name: Dibrihso (Women's Milk Container)

Use: Women drink milk from the Dibrihso; men are forbidden to touch it.



Name: 'Diri (clay pot)

Use: Cook food and meat.

Make: Clay.

By: Blacksmiths and Orro=hunters and gatherous.

Price: One uncastrated he goat or lamb.



Name: Uruub (Camel Milking Container)

Use: Used for milking camels and also for prayer during libation rituals.

Make: Woven from doom palm leaves by women, then strengthened through fumigation.
